## GO MAKE DISCIPLES—THE JUBILEE YEAR INDULGENCE

As you enter the front door of St. Mary Church, you will see that the inside doors are framed with a golden drape to denote that you will be passing through a Holy Door. Passing through this doorway affords each pilgrim an opportunity to gain the special Jubilee Year plenary indulgence. To earn this indulgence, a person must complete the usual four requirements.



To explain, an indulgence is the remittance (or erasing) of temporal punishment due to forgiven sin. Yes, our sins are forgiven in Confession; the spiritual turning away from God through our sins is completely forgiven, is erased from our souls. However, sin is both spiritual and physical because we are both soul and body. What remains, is the temporal punishment due to our sins.

This temporal punishment is like a shadow left on a white board after the words written on it are erased...the former writing can still be somewhat discerned, though dimly...the board is not perfectly clean. Since no one can enter Heaven until the soul is perfectly holy, holy, holy...all the temporal punishment due to our sins must be eradicated. Each time a person says prayers, gives alms, does penance, or performs good works for the love of God, a partial indulgence is earned, meaning that part of the temporal punishment is removed.

The Jubilee Year offers the chance to earn not just a partial indulgence, but a plenary indulgence. A plenary indulgence means that the soul is completely purified; all the temporal punishment due to all the sins that remains on the soul is eliminated. To earn that plenary indulgence, one needs to satisfy four requirements and pass through the Holy Door.

### The four requirements are as follows:

- Be completely detached from all sin
- Receive Holy Communion on that day
- Go to Confession on that day or within 20 days
- Pray for the intentions of the Pope.

That sounds pretty easy, especially the first requirement, but that may be the hardest requirement. It means that persons must hate all their sins and renounce any attachment to their sins. They must be actively trying to avoid any situations that might lead them to sin again. They must intend to change their ways to avoid all sin. We say that in the Act of Contrition, “I detest all my sins...because they offend Thee, my God, Who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin.” To earn a plenary indulgence, a person must really mean it.

## ST. MARY PROCLAIMED A JUBILEE YEAR PILGRIMAGE SITE

The diocese named St. Mary Church to be one of six sites at which the Jubilee Year Indulgence may be earned. The front door of the church will have Holy Door status from now until the end of the Jubilee Year. The parish welcomes pilgrims from our own parish, from the diocese, and beyond to pass through the door, pray before the Blessed Sacrament, go to Confession, attend Mass, receive Holy Communion, and pray for the intention of our Holy Father, the Pope. What a great honor and privilege that our church has received this designation.

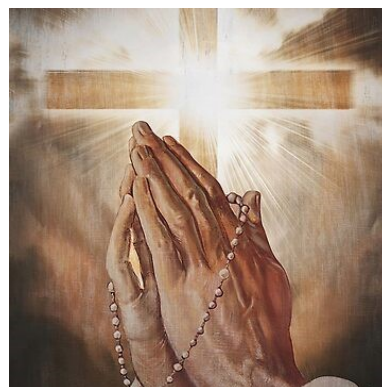

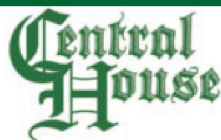

A brief biography of each person follows:

### Position—Treasurer Trustee

#### Length of Term: 3 years

**Jeri Novinska** has been an active member of St. Mary Church/Queen of All Saints Parish during her more than 50 years of membership. She was a member of the last St. Mary Parish Council and served as Church Treasurer. During the initial phase of the St. Mary-St. John Nepomuc-St. Lawrence merger in 2013, Jeri continued as interim treasurer.
