EVANGELIZATION

GO MAKE DISCIPLES—HISTORY

In 2020 Bishop Hying announced his plan to assist all Catholics to answer Christ's last directive before He ascended into Heaven. Jesus told his apostles in the final chapter of the gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke to go make disciples of all nations.



At that time each parish was invited to form a committee that would meet monthly to learn about our Catholic Faith, to learn how to become disciple makers, and to spread this information among all parish members. At Corpus Christi the committee was named the

Go Make Disciples Team, and at Queen of All Saints the committee was named the Evangelism Team.

In addition to those monthly meetings, the two teams have been meeting as a single committee four times each year for over a year. At this time of transition from being Pastorate 4 to being Our Lady of the Most Blessed Sacrament Parish, on February 13 the teams formally united into a single Go Make Disciples Team. The GMD team will meet monthly and alternate between Corpus Christi in Boscobel and St. Mary in Fennimore.

What has been happening in these past four years? This Go Make Disciples News Corner has been printed in the bulletin for more than three years. Each article informs parishioners about some aspect of the Catholic Faith. The articles began by discussing the Four Holy Habits, practices that help Catholics to increase in holiness:

Reclaim Sunday	Attend Mass; be with family; avoid work.
Daily Prayer	Commit to at least 15 minutes daily.
Regular Mortification	Start with penance/sacrifice on Fridays.
Frequent Confession	Confess sins at least once a month.

Catholics are all invited to spread the good news of the gospel...this task is for everyone. Sadly, in recent years Catholics have become less active in personally spreading the Word of God and have mostly relegated this task to priests and CCD teachers. A quick look around our churches on Sunday mornings readily shows that many of our family, friends, and neighbors who are Catholic are absent. Clearly, all need to take responsibility for the salvation of the souls of our loved ones as well as for our own souls.

Participating in the Lenten Rosary Challenge, the Rosary in a Year, the Bible in a Year, the Catechism in a Year, the Lenten Retreat, Book Studies, small group meetings, Parish Pilgrimages, the Men of Christ Conference, Eucharistic Adoration, KCs, CCW meetings and events, parish fish fries, parish festivals, etc., etc., etc., all contribute to being a parish family. Getting to know each other as individuals and families assists everyone in their spiritual growth.

The GMD Team invites you to continue your "work" to gather souls for Christ. We have but one life to live on earth, but an eternity with Christ awaits us. The Bible states (see James 5:20) that saving just one more soul for Heaven is a sign of salvation for the person who made the effort to spread the gospel. Let us "work" and pray to save many souls.
