Remembering the Holy Souls in Purgatory

While on earth, we, the **Church Militant** strive to become holy. Only during earthly life can a soul affect its own holiness. At the <u>particular judgment</u> when entering eternity, each soul will be judged by Jesus Christ with one of three outcomes.

- A soul is completely holy, filled with grace, and enters Heaven.
- A soul is completely unholy--even one mortal sin--contains no grace and enters Hell.
- A soul is not completely purified, contains some grace, but has unconfessed venial sins and/or temporal punishment due to sins, and enters Purgatory--the **Church Suffering**.

The Holy Souls suffer the pain of purification willingly, knowing that they will eventually enter Heaven--their souls have been saved through Jesus' death on the cross. Once in eternity a soul can no longer help itself. The living assist the souls in Purgatory to enter Heaven and become part of the **Church Tri-umphant**. We have a duty to help them. We earn a <u>partial indulgence</u> if we

- Offer prayers, sacrifices, good deeds, and alms for the Holy Souls.
- Offer Mass and Holy Communion or have a Mass said for souls in Purgatory.
- Ask our guardian angels to visit the Holy Souls to comfort them.

A <u>plenary indulgence</u> may be obtained once each day to release one soul from Purgatory. To obtain a plenary indulgence (remission of all temporal punishment) for a Holy Soul, named or unknown, do **one** of the following four devotions:

- 1. Family Rosary or pray it with others in church or chapel or
- 2. Scripture (read ½ hr.) or
- 3. Adoration ($\frac{1}{2}$ hr.) **or**
- 4. Stations in church or chapel

Plus do all of these next 3:

- a. Holy Communion (each day one wishes to gain the plenary indulgence).
- b. Prayers for the Holy Father (Our Father and Hail Mary (each day).
- c. Confession within 20 days before or after (have no attachment to sin, even venial sin).

The meeting will begin at 7:30 PM in the church basement.




